WHAT //

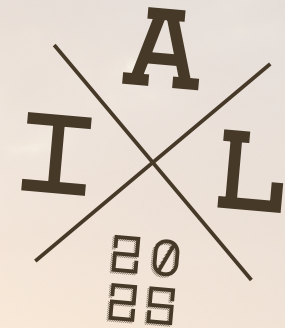
